

Regulations for Students' Application for Double Registration to I-Shou University

Adopted on October 9, 2009 at the 1st meeting of the University Academic Council in the 1st semester of the academic year 2009

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Promulgated with the consent of the President dated on January 13, 2010

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- Article 1 The Regulations for Students' Application for Double Registration to I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations") are made pursuant to Article 28 of the University Act and Article 3 of the Academic Rules of I-Shou University.
- Article 2 The term "double registration" mentioned herein refers to a second registration either at any other departments of I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as "the University") or at any local/overseas institutions of higher education held by students officially enrolled at the University.
- Article 3 The Regulations are applicable to students with double registration who pursue a formal degree at the University and whose years of study comply with one of the following requirements:
1. at least 6 semesters for undergraduate students and at least 10 semesters for undergraduate students in the School of Chinese Medicine for Post Baccalaureate;
 2. at least 2 semesters for master's students; and

3. at least 4 semesters for doctoral students.

- Article 4 In principle, students shall apply for double registration to different divisions or education systems. In addition, the course session(s) taken at another institution (including the time required for traveling between two locations) shall not overlap with that (those) of the electives taken at the University.
- Article 5 The credits and grades that students with double registration earn in another institution shall not be computed with the semester grades and credits earned at the University. Students who are required to submit a thesis/dissertation shall not propose the same thesis/dissertation with identical titles and contents to the two institutions; otherwise, the degree conferred by the University will be revoked, and such a student will be asked to return the diploma issued to him/her.
- Article 6 Students shall apply for double registration in accordance with the Regulations before the beginning of the semester in which they hold double registration. Students who study in another institution without prior application or granted approval from the University shall be expelled from the University.
Students who have double registration at the University shall pay the tuition and other required fees based on their student status.
- Article 7 Studying for a degree in foreign institutions shall be governed by the Regulations for International Dual Degree Programs with Foreign Universities and Colleges and exempted from Articles 3 and 5 of the Regulations.
- Article 8 Any matter not mentioned herein shall be subject to the Academic Rules of I-Shou University.
- Article 9 The Regulations become effective on the third day of promulgation after being adopted by the University Academic Council, the University Administration Council, and the University Council, ratified by the President, and reported to the Ministry of Education for future reference. The same procedure applies to any amendment to the Regulations.

Note: In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or terms of the Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
