

# Regulations for Encouragement to Outstanding New Enrollees at Undergraduate Programs of I-Shou University

Ratified and Promulgated by the President on June 2, 2008

Amendments to the Regulations ratified and promulgated by the Board of Trustees on June 6, 2010

- Article 1 The Regulations for Encouragement to Outstanding New Enrollees at Undergraduate Programs of I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as the “Regulations”) are enacted to magnetize excellent senior high students applying for admission by recommendation & screening or examinees scoring high on Department Required Test to pursue undergraduate degrees at the University.
- Article 2 The Office of Student Affairs (hereinafter referred to as the “Office”) takes full charge of affairs related to the encouragement program.
- Article 3 The incentive standards for outstanding newly-admitted students may vary every year and are drawn up by the Office by the end of every October after all factors are taken into account. The incentive standards take effect after adopted by the University Administration Council, ratified by the President and approved by the Board of Trustees.
- Article 4 The Office of Academic Affairs shall provide the Office with a list of new enrollees who satisfy incentive qualifications and complete the registration procedures. The Office shall then submit the list to the President for approval of

incentives to qualified students.

Article 5 Qualified new enrollees will be deemed disqualified from receiving the incentives should they suspend schooling or are expelled, but the University will not ask these students to return the incentives granted to them.

Article 6 Qualified new enrollees may apply for any of the other ISU or non-ISU scholarships during their studies at the University so long as they satisfy the qualifications of respective scholarships.

Article 7 Any issue not mentioned herein shall be subject to supplementary provisions, if any.

Article 8 The Regulations become effective on the day of promulgation upon adoption by the University Administration Council, ratification by the President and approval by the Board of Trustees.

*Note: In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or terms of these Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.*
