

Regulations for Awarding of Outstanding Doctoral Student Scholarship at I-Shou University

Adopted on August 8, 1999

Amendments adopted on July 21, 2000

Amendments to the Regulations ratified and promulgated by the President on November 6, 2010; amendments take effect on February 1, 2011

Partial amendments to the Regulations ratified and promulgated by the President on October 11, 2012

Article 1 The Regulations for Awarding of Outstanding Doctoral Student Scholarship at I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as the “Regulations”) are hereby established to encourage doctoral students to be devoted to both academic studies and research.

Article 2 Application Requirements:

1. being one first-year or second-year doctoral student officially enrolled at I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as the “University”);
2. having received an average semester grade of 80 or higher and a conduct score of 80 or higher for the previous semester (newly-admitted doctoral students are exempted from this requirement); and
3. being recommended by one full-time faculty member of the department (institute/program) where he/she studies.

Regarding the requirement referred to in Subparagraph 1 of the preceding paragraph, doctoral students are allowed to apply for this scholarship only within two years of being admitted to the University. Those who resume graduate studies from suspension and are placed in the third year are not eligible to apply.

Article 3 Doctoral students getting involved in any of the following situations are not eligible to apply:

1. having suspended the studies or withdrawn from the University at the current semester; if a scholarship recipient suspends his/her studies or withdraws from the University in the semester of receiving the scholarship, he/she will be required to return the scholarship in full to the University;
2. having received the Scholarship for International Students from the University or enjoyed tuition discounts for overseas programs; or
3. having received the Scholarship for Outstanding New Enrollees of Master’s/Doctoral Programs.

Article 4 Application Deadlines:

1. First Semester: applications shall be submitted from the beginning of the first semester to October 15 every year.
2. Second Semester: applications shall be submitted from the beginning of the second semester to March 15 every year.

Article 5 Documents to be submitted:

1. a completed scholarship application form;
2. the original academic transcript for the previous semester; and

3. a signed affidavit.

Article 6 Qualified scholarship recipients will be awarded NT\$20,000 each.

Article 7 A scholarship recipient list will be made public upon completion of application review by the Scholarship Review Committee.

The Scholarship Review Committee is headed by the President as chairperson, and committee members are: vice presidents, Dean of Academic Affairs, Dean of Student Affairs, Dean of General Affairs, Secretary-General, Director of Continuing Education, college deans, and Dean of Accounting.

Article 8 The Regulations become effective on the third day of promulgation after being adopted by the University Administration Council and ratified by the President.

Note: In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or terms of these Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
