

Regulations for Encouragement and Guidance to Outstanding Student Athletes at I-Shou University

Adopted on December 1, 2002 in the meeting of the Student Affairs Council

Ratified and promulgated by the President on August 15, 2003

Article 1 The Regulations for Encouragement and Guidance to Outstanding Student Athletes at I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as the “Regulations”) are enacted as per the Promotion Project of Sports for All of the Executive Yuan and the Guidelines on Cultivation of Outstanding Athletes at Universities and Colleges of the Ministry of Education to attract outstanding student athletes to the University, winning honor for the University and creating a university-wide sports climate.

Article 2 Eligibility and Scholarship Amount:

1. Those who have represented the country in the Olympic Games, the World Games, the Asian Games or international/regional/Asian-Pacific tournaments organized by the International Sports Federations/an Asian federation, and have been ranked first to third in the most recent two years will be awarded up to NT\$60,000 per semester.
2. Those (1) who have represented the country in the Olympic Games, the World Games, the Asian Games or international/regional/Asian-Pacific tournaments organized by the International Sports Federations/an Asian federation, and have been ranked fourth to eighth or (2) who have been ranked first to third in the National Games of Republic of China in the most recent two years will be awarded up to NT\$30,000 per semester.
3. Those (1) who have been ranked fourth to sixth in the National Games of Republic of China, (2) who have been ranked first to third in the National High School Games, or (3) who have been ranked first to third in the First Division of the National High School Ball Games in the most recent two years will be awarded up to NT\$20,000 per semester.
4. Those (1) who have been ranked fourth to sixth in the National High School Games, (2) who have been ranked first to third in a national tournament, or (3) who have been ranked fourth to eighth in the First Division or first to third in the

Second Division of the National High School Ball Games in the most recent two years will be awarded up to NT\$10,000 per semester.

5. New enrollees who have been admitted to the University via recommendation and screening will be awarded up to NT\$15,000 per semester, while those admitted to the University via screening and examination will be awarded up to NT\$10,000 per semester.
6. Applicants shall select one from the scholarship options referred to in the preceding five subparagraphs and file the best application. Recipients may be awarded the scholarship for up to four year.
7. As for student athletes with remarkable sports achievements in group competitions, they may be awarded the scholarship only after the Student Affairs Council makes an inspection on their performance and recognizes their achievements.

Article 3 Student athletes getting involved in any of the following situations shall be immediately suspended from receiving the scholarship:

1. being disciplined with a major demerit or above;
2. being considered by the Office of Physical Education as being unable to collaborate with his/her coach, receive training and take part in competitions; or
3. discontinuing training because of sports injuries; they will not be asked to return the scholarship they have received, but no more scholarship will be awarded.

Article 4 The scholarship will be awarded to recipients at the end of every semester. The University reserves the right to ask a recipient to return the scholarship received at a certain semester if he/she suspends schooling or withdraws from the University during the semester.

Article 5 Scholarship recipients shall first complete registration procedures and pay the tuition and miscellaneous fees, and then file an application within one month of beginning of classes.

Article 6 Outstanding student athletes may file another application as per the Regulations for Scholarship for Students with Excellent Performances in Sports at I-Shou University if they represent the University in off-campus competitions and win honor for the University after trained by the University.

Article 7 The Regulations become effective on the day of promulgation after adopted by the Student Affairs Council and ratified by the President. The same procedure applies to any amendment to the Regulations.

Note: In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or

terms of these Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
