

Regulations for Rewarding Students with Outstanding Sports

Achievements at I-Shou University

Adopted on December 1, 2002 at the Office Affairs Council
of Student Affairs

Ratified and promulgated by the President on August 15,
2003

Article 1 In accordance with the *Promoting Sports for All Plan* promulgated by the Executive Yuan and the *Regulations of Training of Outstanding Athletic Talents at Universities or Colleges* promulgated by Ministry of Education, the *Regulations for Rewarding Students with Outstanding Sports Achievements at I-Shou University* (hereinafter referred to as the “Regulations”) is hereby established to attract athletic talents to study at the University, win honors for the University and improve the athletics standard within the University.

Article 2 The qualification of grant recipients and the approved amount of grants:

1. Students who have been selected as the players of National Sports Teams, and have participated and won the top three prizes in Olympics Games, World Games, Asian Games or world/intercontinental/Asia Pacific Region championships held by international federations or Asia/Asia Pacific regional federations of individual sports within the recent two years shall be granted a maximum amount of NT\$60,000 in each semester.
2. Students who have been selected as the players of National Sports Teams, and have participated and won the 4th-8th places in Olympics Games, World Games, Asian Games or world/intercontinental/Asia Pacific Region championships held by international federations or Asia/Asia Pacific regional federations of individual sports, or those who have won the top three prizes in the National Athletic Games within the recent two years shall be granted a maximum amount of NT\$30,000 in each semester.
3. Students who have won the 4th-6th places in the National Athletic Games, or won the top three prizes in the National High School Sports Competition or the National League for ball games (Group A) within the recent two years shall be granted a maximum amount of NT\$20,000 in each semester.
4. Students who have won the 4th-6th places in the National High School Sports Competition, or won the top three prizes in national championships of individual

sports, or won the 4th-8th places in Group A or the top three prizes in Group B in the National League for ball games within the recent two years shall be granted a maximum amount of NT\$10,000 in each semester.

5. Students who are enrolled in the University via the recommendation & screening by Ministry of Education shall be granted with a maximum amount of NT\$15,000 in each semester. Students who are admitted to the University via the examination & screening shall be granted with a maximum amount of NT\$ 10,000 in each semester.
6. Students who satisfy the aforesaid qualifications shall apply for the most preferable grant, and the period of scholarship granted shall not exceed four years.
7. The Student Affairs Committee shall review students' actual performances in the competitions before giving grants to students with outstanding achievements in team sports.

Article 3 The grants shall be suspended if the following circumstances happen:

1. Students who are assigned major demerits or other punishments of similar severity.
2. Students who are not able to follow the instructions given by coaches/teachers or to attend trainings and competitions regularly as judged by the Office of Physical Education.
3. Students who suspend the trainings due to sports injuries will no longer receive any grants, and the University shall not pursue the grants that have been granted.

Article 4 The grants shall be granted before the end of each semester, and the recipients shall return all the scholarship received at the current semester without objection if they apply for suspension or withdrawal from the University.

Article 5 Recipients shall complete registration and pay the tuition and miscellaneous fees, and apply for the grants one month after the semester begins.

Article 6 Excellent student players shall apply for Scholarship for Students with Excellent Performances in Sports if they represent the University to participate in the sports competitions and win honors for the University after receiving training.

Article 7 The Regulations become effective on the third day of promulgation upon the adoption by the Office Affairs Council of Student Affairs and ratification by the President. Amendments must also undergo the same procedures.

Note: In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or terms of the Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
